**Are you interested in conducting world-class research in state-of-the-art facilities at one of Australia's top Medical Research Institutions?**

We are recruiting highly motivated and tenacious students for our Honours, Masters and PhD Programs for 2019. **We seek students with an interest in understanding the mechanisms of how stress contributes to the development of mental illness.** Candidates should have a background in neuroscience, molecular biology or bioinformatics. Students with experience in wet labs (especially microscopy techniques) and computational biology will be strongly considered.

Projects will be mainly focused on analyzing postmortem human brain tissues, with additional scope for computational biologists to assess new and existing datasets. Research will be conducted at the Illawarra Health and Medical Research Institute (IHMRI) at the University of Wollongong (UOW). IHMRI houses world class facilities, including the only Synchropatch 384-well high throughput electrophysiology system and one of only two cryo-EM facilities in Australia.

UOW is a globally rated five-star university in the top 2% of all universities in the world, boasting an international reputation for world-class research, exceptional teaching and graduate outcomes. The campus is in the coastal city of Wollongong, approximately 80km south of Sydney, Australia.
